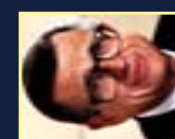

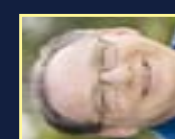

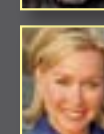
MATHEW D. STAVER

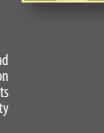

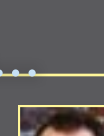
DAVE EARLEY

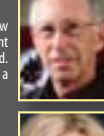
TOMMY WALKER

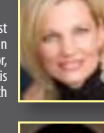
DOUG RANDLETT
